International calls to all countries not included in the International Calling Card 25 will be charged at the standard international rate card price. The minutes in the International Calling Card 25 will be valid for 30 days from the date of the card is loaded. Any remaining minutes after the 30 day period will be lost. Calls to countries included in the International Calling Card 25 will be charged from the included International Calling Card 25 minutes first. When the International Calling Card 25 minutes have run out, then all international calls including countries included in the International Calling Card 25 will be charged at the standard rate card price. If a customer does not have any Red or Freedom value left, then they will not be able to make any calls, however they will be able to receive local and international calls as well as receive SMS for 60 days from the date the card was loaded.
